Measures to Prevent the Spread of the Novel Coronavirus during the 2nd Hinokko Piano Competition +

As of June 1, 2021

The following steps will be taken to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus during the 2nd Hinokko Piano Competition +. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

■ Hygiene management

- All areas in the venue, such as handrails in corridors, will be disinfected with alcohol.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed at the reception desk and in the foyer.
- Notices will be posted with information about measures for preventing infection, such as proper coughing etiquette.
- Air-conditioning and ventilation will draw air from outside the venue into the hall, foyer, and waiting rooms (24 hours).

Avoiding closed spaces

- Doors leading to audience seating will remain open during the performances.
- Staff members will ventilate rehearsal rooms on a regular schedule.

Avoiding crowds

- A limit will be placed on the number of people allowed in the venue.
- Staff members will guide the queue leading to the reception desk.
- A schedule will be made for times when rehearsal rooms can be used.

Avoiding close contact

Suitable spacing will be provided between seats.

■ Health management

- Everyone who comes to the venue must use hand sanitizer and consent to a temperature check.
 (Persons with a temperature of 37.5°C or higher will not be allowed to enter the venue or participate in the event.)
- Staff members will undergo temperature checks and physical examinations before the event starts.
- Everyone participating in this competition will be required to wear a mask.

Additional measures will be taken as necessary in the run-up to the day of the event.

Please cooperate with all instructions given by staff members on the day of the event.
